How do I get there? – (Route from Central Station to St.Louis)

Take **Tram A** (direction "Illkirch") or **Tram D** (direction "Aristide Briand"); change at 2nd Station: "Homme de Fer" to **Tram B** (direction "Hoenheim"); change at 5th Station "Wacken" to **Tram E** (direction "Robertsau") until terminal "Robertsau-Boecklin"; from there go straight ahead and turn left at Rue Jeanne d'Arc (3rd street on the left), walk until Church St. Louis

6. We pray for all the persons involved in the abortion process (doctors, politicians etc.), so that love for the innocent and defenceless babies may be kindled in their hearts.
